Complete parcel of wood and fittings 2/2 post free.

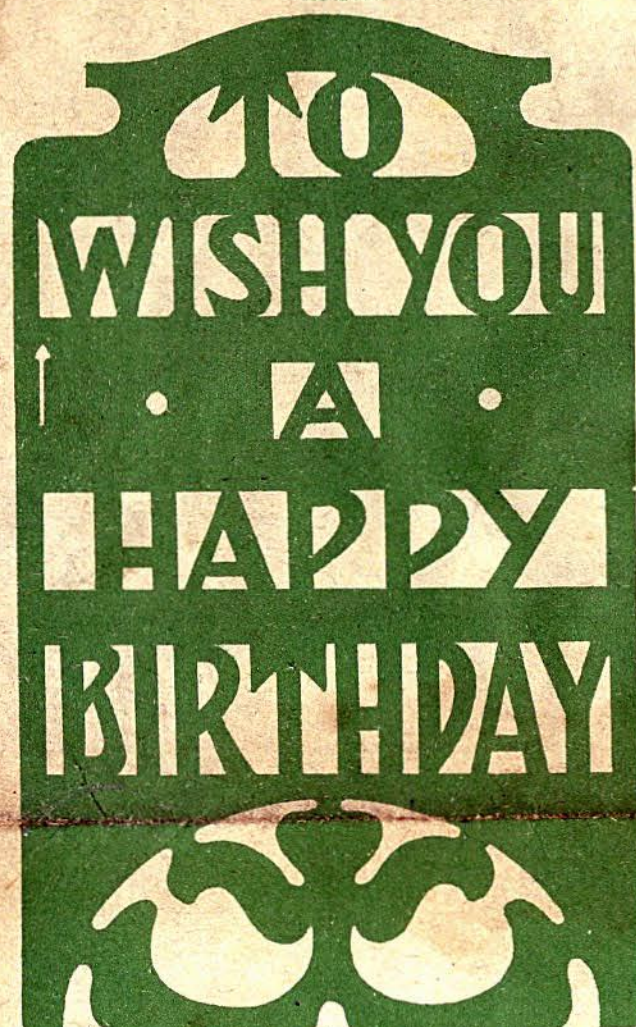
The above prices are subject to alteration without notice.

The backs of the fretted cards should receive the glue when putting on the thin backing wood. They should be put under weights until glue has hardened.

The arrows indicate the direction of grain of wood.

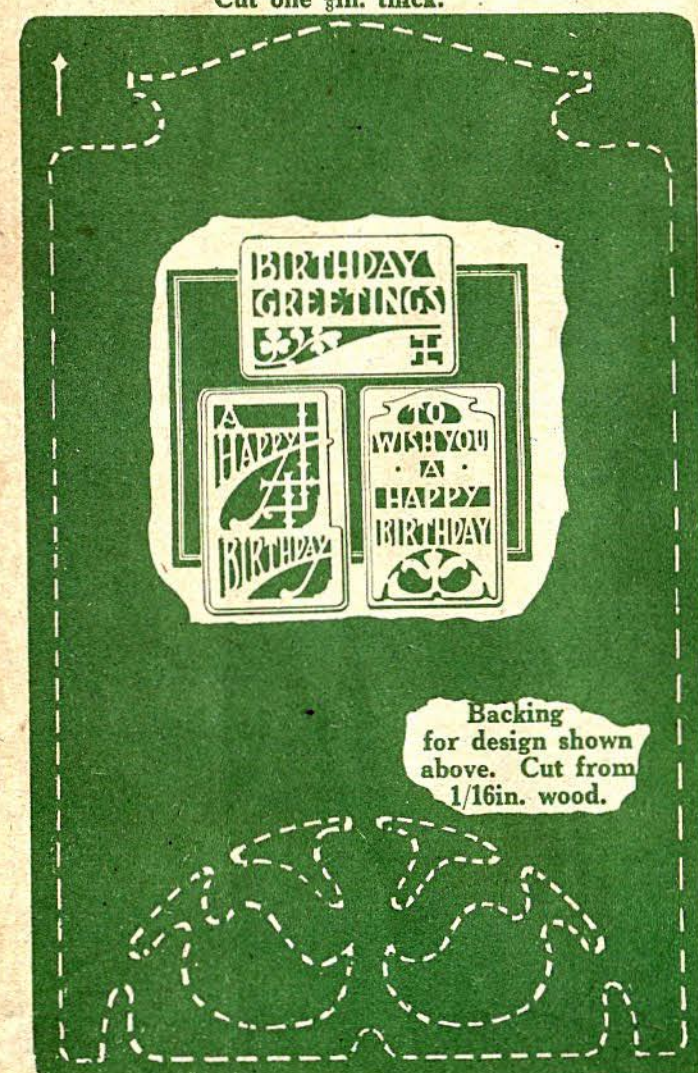
Cut one 1/16 in. thick.



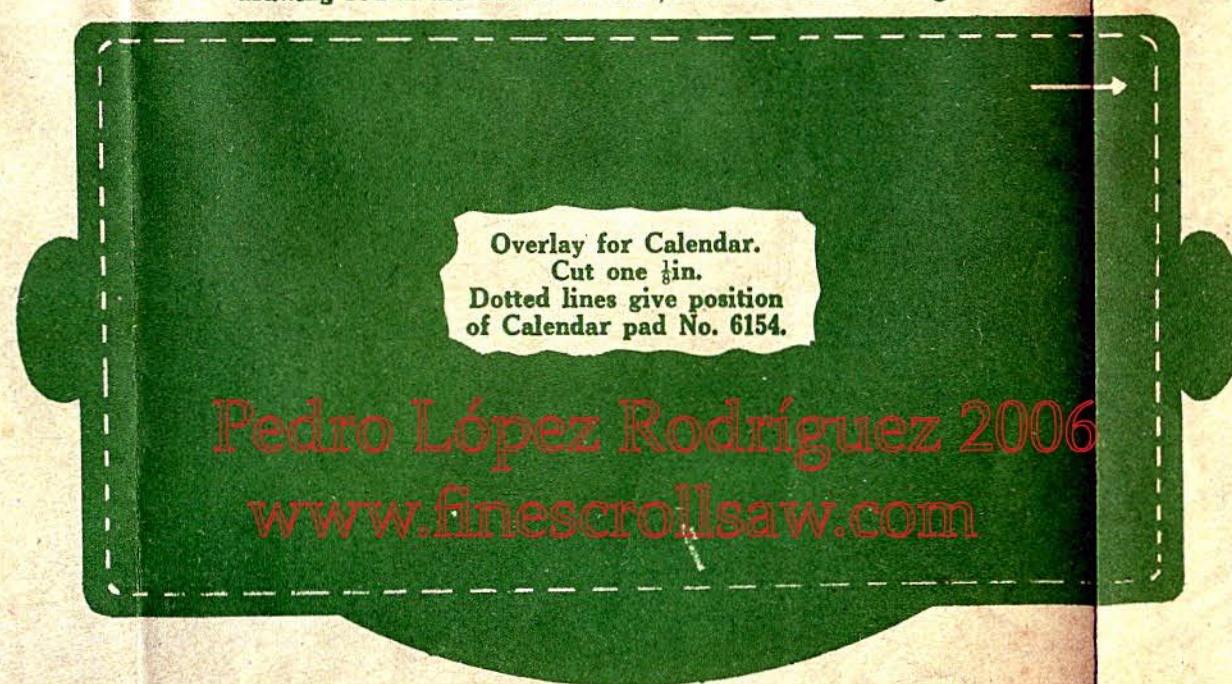
Backing for design shown on left. Cut from 1/16 in. wood.



Greeting Card. Cut from 1/16 in. wood. Form a backing for it by drawing round the outline on to 1/16 in. wood and cutting out.



Backing for design shown above. Cut from 1/16 in. wood.



Overlay for Calendar. Cut one 1/16 in. Dotted lines give position of Calendar pad No. 6154.

A piece of Japanese Veneer or tinted paper would show the owl up well if glued behind in this space.

Calendar, Back. Cut one 3/16 in. Dotted lines give position of overlay which is to be glued on. Two glass Owl's eyes to be fixed by wire to Back.
