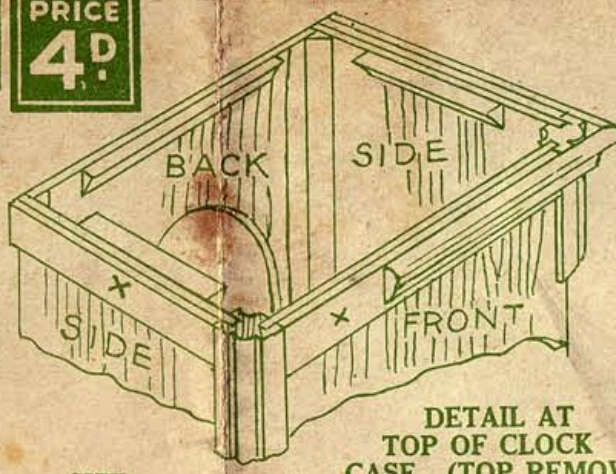


STANDING NURSERY CLOCK

Having a novel chain and weight movement simple to assemble.

FRETWOOD AND FITTINGS.

For making this Clock a parcel of Spanish Chestnut and Plywood is supplied, with sufficient No. 45 and 303 Moulding, also angle fillet, and ornamental Fret No. 803. 9/-, carriage paid 10/6. FITTINGS.—Pendulum Clock with chain and weight, fancy dial and all fittings, complete for making movement. 2/11, post free 3/5. A complete parcel of Wood, Moulding, Fillet and Clock fitting will be sent carriage paid 13/6. The above prices are subject to alteration.

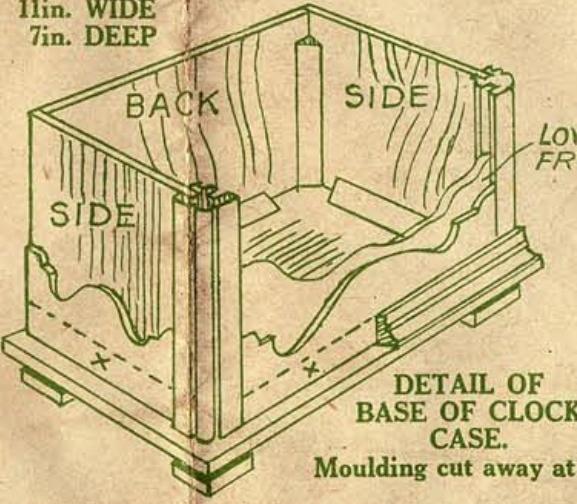
CORNER Moulding

Required.



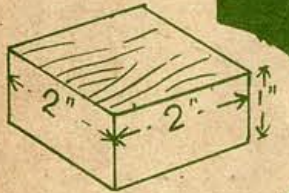

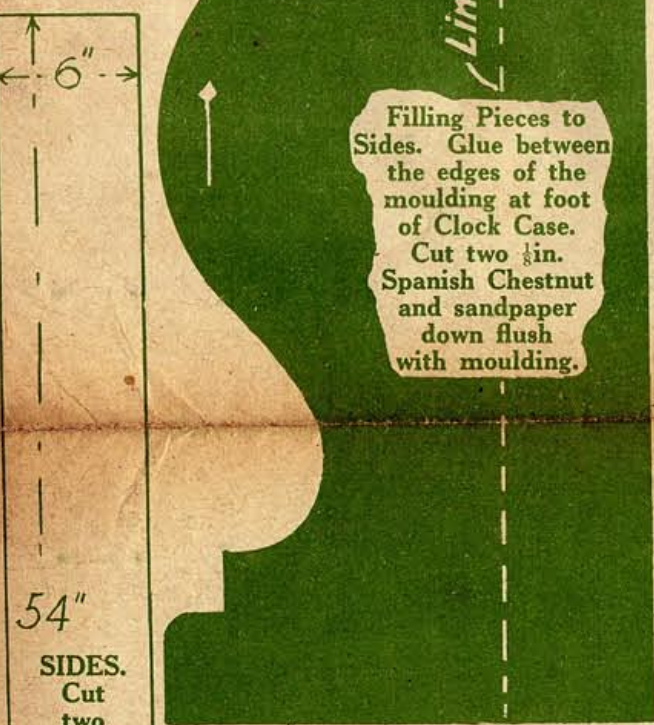
DETAIL OF BASE OF CLOCK CASE.
Moulding cut away at XX.

Filling Slips for Grooved Moulding.
Cut two pieces 3/16 in. Plywood to length and glue into grooves between upper and lower front sections.

CENTRE LINE

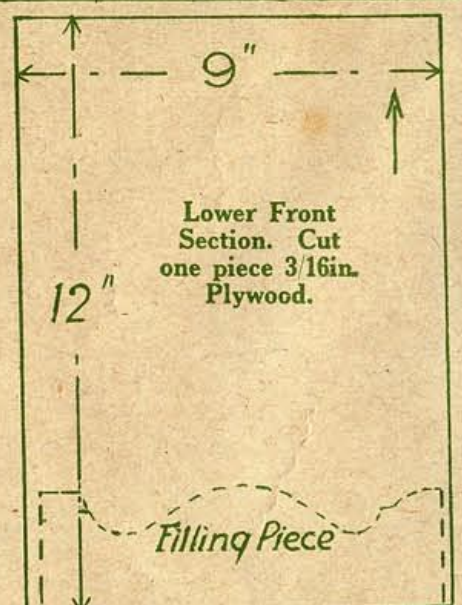


Deal Blocks as Feet. Four required.



Filling Pieces to Sides. Glue between the edges of the moulding at foot of Clock Case. Cut two 1/2 in. Spanish Chestnut and sandpaper down flush with moulding.

54" SIDES. Cut two 3/16 in. Plywood.



Lower Front Section. Cut one piece 3/16 in. Plywood.

Filling Piece



Floor and Top. Cut one piece 1/2 in. Spanish Chestnut and one piece 3/16 in. plywood.

Filling Piece to Front. Glue between the edges of the moulding at foot of Case. Cut one 1/2 in. and sandpaper down flush with moulding.

Filling Piece to Front, Middle Section B. Cut one 1/2 in. and sandpaper down flush with moulding.

Filling Pieces to Sides, Top. Cut two 1/2 in. and sandpaper down.

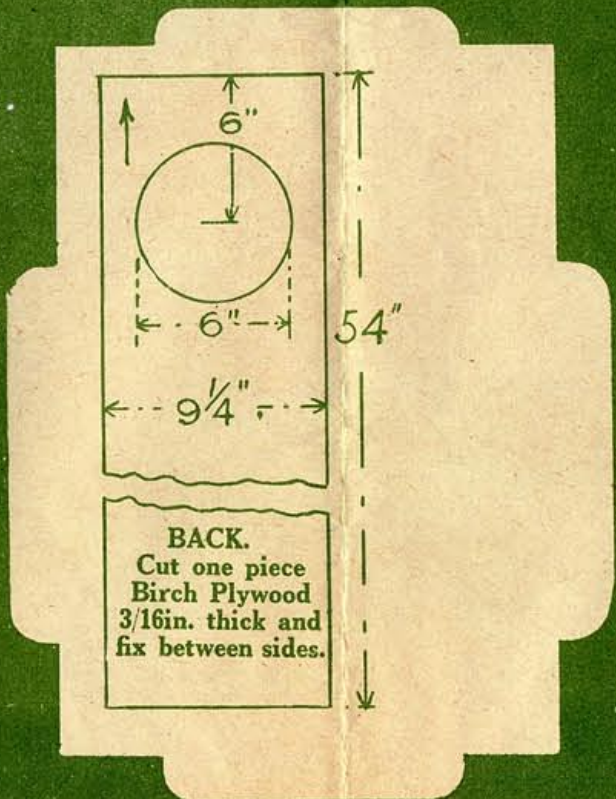
Filling Piece to Front A, Top. Cut one 1/2 in. and sandpaper down.

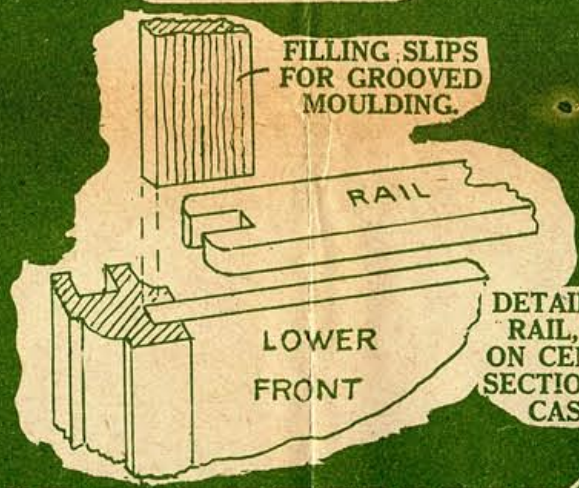

Cut this piece away to allow of clock movement.

BACK. Cut one piece Birch Plywood 3/16 in. thick and fix between sides.



CARD FACE OF CLOCK SCREWED TO PLYWOOD FRONT

FRONT, TOP. Cut one piece 3/16 in. Plywood.

Filling Piece B (Middle Section)

Filling Pieces to Sides, Middle Section B. Cut two 1/2 in. and sandpaper down flush with moulding.
