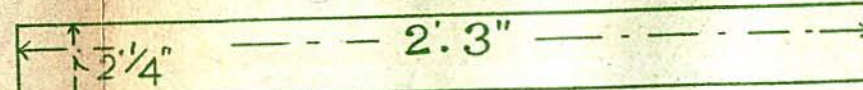

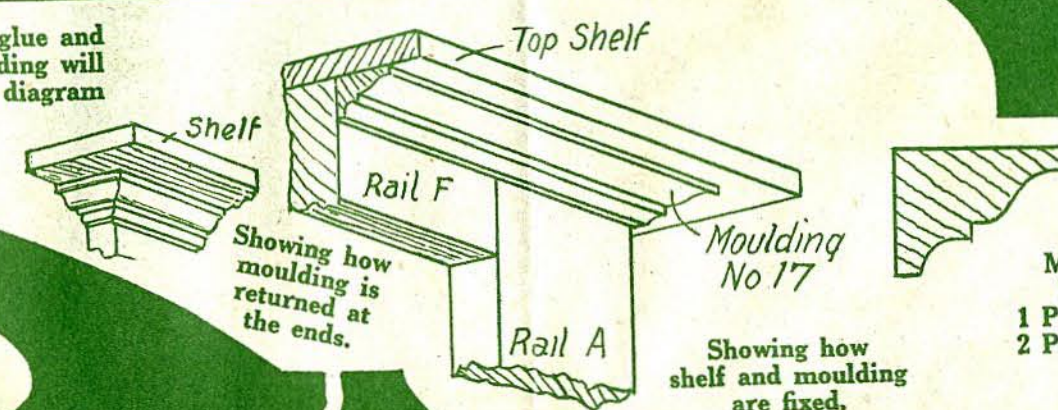

below.



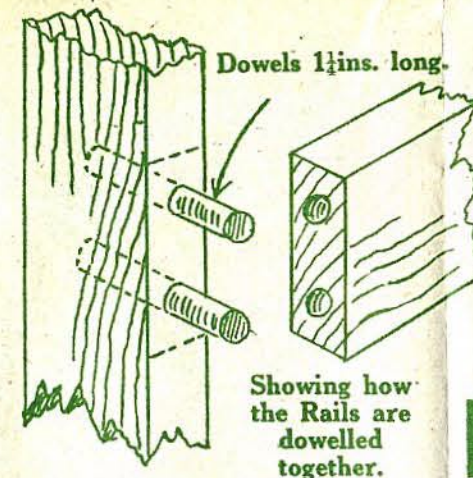

latter are dowelled to Rails H.H.

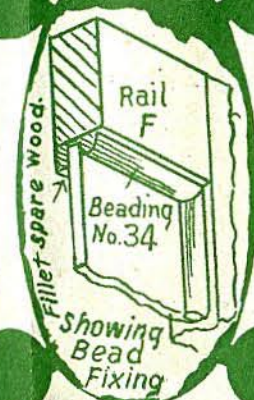
Showing how
